## **Announcement of SI-3**

The next conference in the Swadeshi Indology Conference Series, titled "Tamil Nadu – The Land of Dharma" was formally announced in May 2017.



There are 6 main themes which will be examined in a scholarly and unbiased manner at this conference which is slated to be held at the end of this year. The themes will be examined from a Swadeshi standpoint and methods include: use of archaeological data, interpretation of original texts, interpretations from dharmic practices such as art forms, oral traditions, rituals, etc. The time frame for submitting abstracts ended on 8th June 2017 and participants are being sent comments on their submitted abstracts. # Rajiv Malhotra speaks at the Embassy of India in Washington

On May 19<sup>th</sup> 2017, Rajiv Malhotra gave a talk at the Embassy of India in Washington on the topic "India's (Unacknowledged) Contributions to Mind Sciences".

In his talk, Rajiv pointed out the immense contributions from the dharma traditions which have been made to the field of mind sciences, psychology, consciousness studies and so on. He pointed out that these contributions have largely gone unacknowledged and that Indians themselves had very little knowledge of them. He dwelt at length on the tendency on the part of westerners to appropriate things from the dharma traditions that they find important to their research, without adequately acknowledging the sources.



He has coined a term for this as <u>Digestion</u>. He also talked about his <u>UTurn theory</u> that many westerners turning to dharma go through which facilitates this process of digestion. The event was followed by a question and answer session too. The video can be seen here.
