


Sangam Talks Interview



Eminent author and researcher Rinkoo Wadhera interviewed Rajiv Malhotra and Vijaya Viswanathan on their book Snakes in the Ganga during this edition of Sangam Talks. In this engaging discussion a lot of including issues are discussed, Americanization of cancel Marxism. culture, Critical Race Theory. Rajiv mentions how teachers are being trained in the US to propagate such views with the help of a large army of sepoys in universities, government, and departments in Indian corporates. In this video, Rajiv Malhotra and the Editorin-Chief of The New Indian, Arti Tikoo Singh, have an engaging discussion on a wide variety of issues on Indian civilization.



They discuss the concept of caste in India and how it differs from race, the false equivalences between Indian minorities and oppressed people elsewhere in the world, and the concept of Western universalism. Government departments and ministries have been unsuccessful in projecting the Indian civilization and establishing the Indian identity. They also discuss democracy with respect to India and its relevance in modern times. America's edge in technology and economics (dollar being the standard) have allowed it to continue its hegemony over the rest of the world. Video.

Discussion with Vivek Agnihotri

In this engaging conversation, note filmmaker Vivek Agnihotri and Rajiv Malhotra discuss various ideas discussed in the book Snakes in the Ganga. Rajiv explains the concept of Americanization of Marxism and its role vis-à-vis the ongoing social upheaval in the U.S. They also talk at length about the coalition of victim identities, particularly in the U.S. and in



India, and the role that Harvard plays in bringing them together to spread its views.



Harvard controls the discourse, with leading Indian billionaires serving as some of its major funders and endorsers. Harvard uses the money to build its own image as the center of the Social Justice movement despite being unacademic in its whole approach. The billionaires' money would have been better spent in establishing liberal arts institutes in India. Video.

Is Niti Aayog infiltrated by Harvard?



Interview with Rahul Shivshankar



Noted Indian news anchor Rahul Shivshankar interviews Rajiv Malhotra on different ideas discussed in the book Snakes in the Ganga. Rajiv explains how Harvard uses its powerful position and clout in India to export American social theories such as Critical Race Theory (CRT)/Wokeism, misapplying it to Indian casteism, ignoring the difference in historical context. On the one hand America wants policies that will continue to favor trade with India but at the same time they want India weak enough so that it doesn't become another China. Therefore, it actively promotes Khalistanis, Kashmiri separatists, Dalits, etc. Anybody speaking against India gets a forum and a very one-sided narrative is built up where the people being attacked don't get to respond, which is propagated in India through liberal arts universities, media houses and popular discourse.
