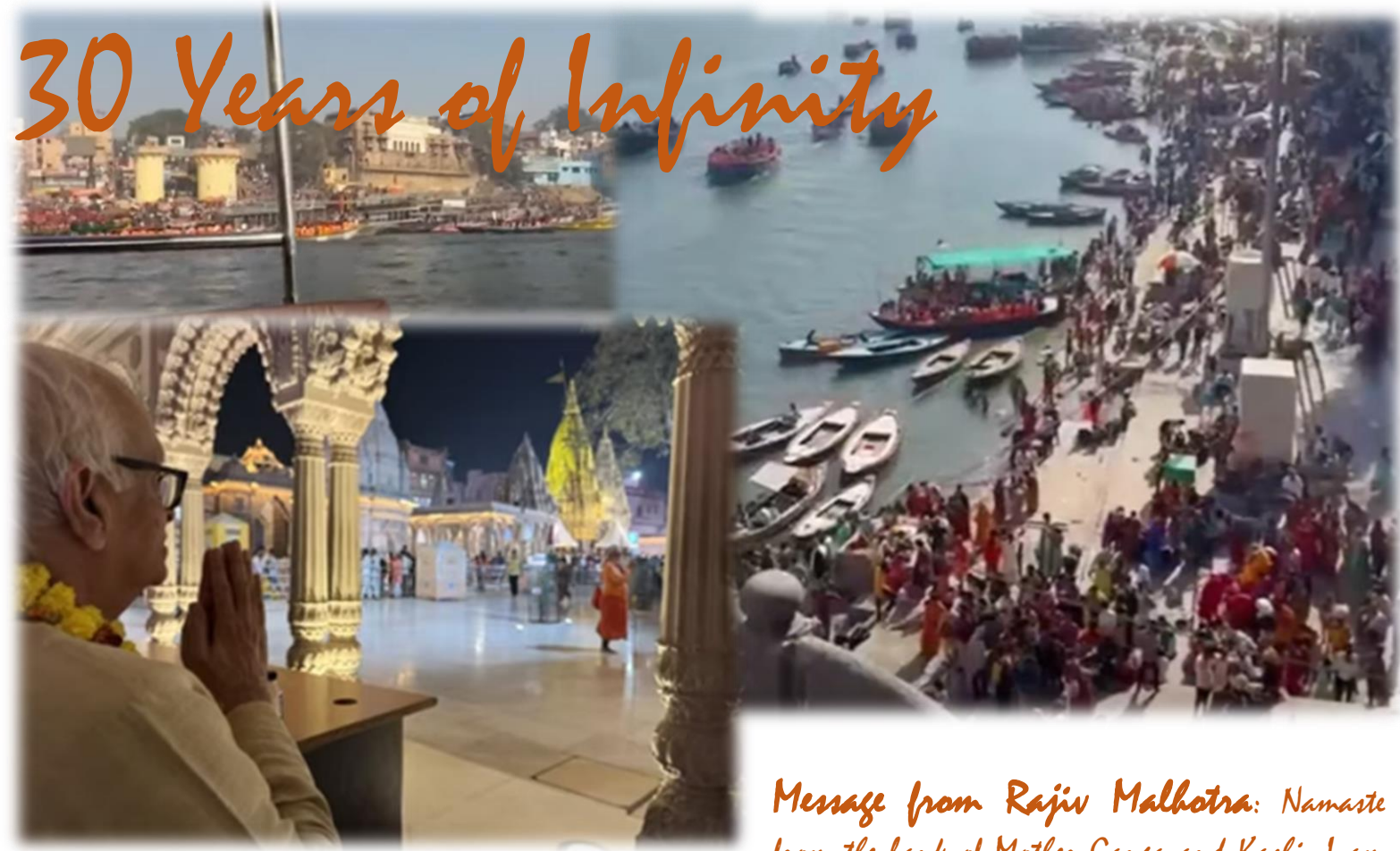




30 Years of Infinity

Rajiv Malhotra Invites You To 30 Years of Infinity Foundation! Join our Grand Celebration!

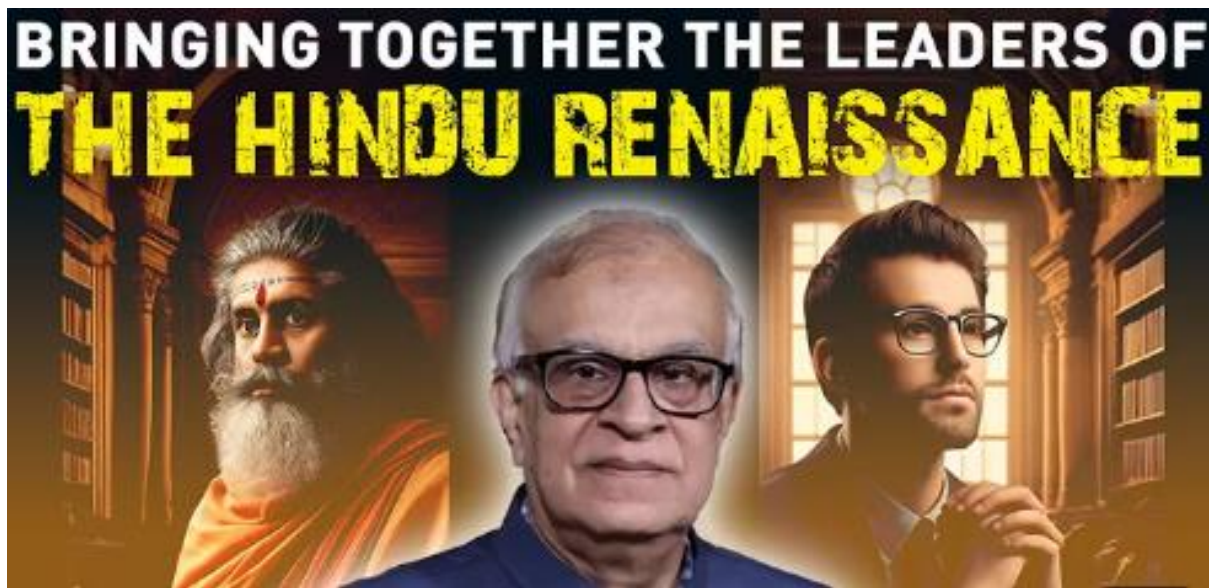

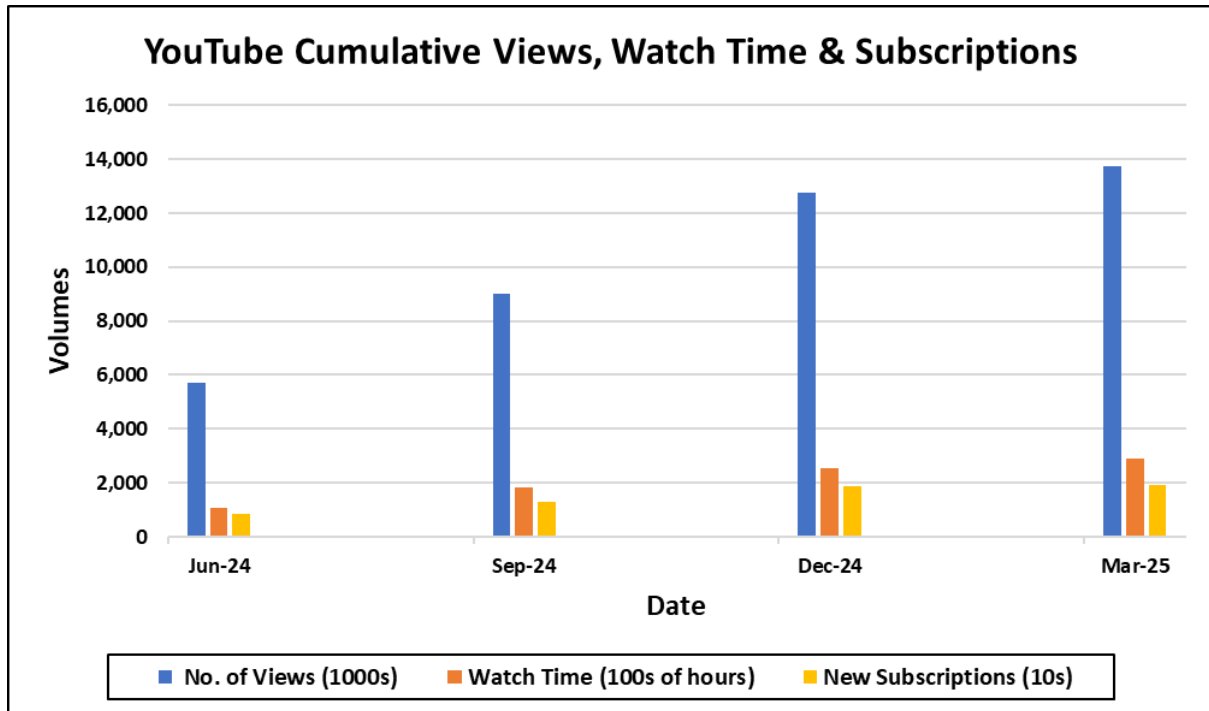

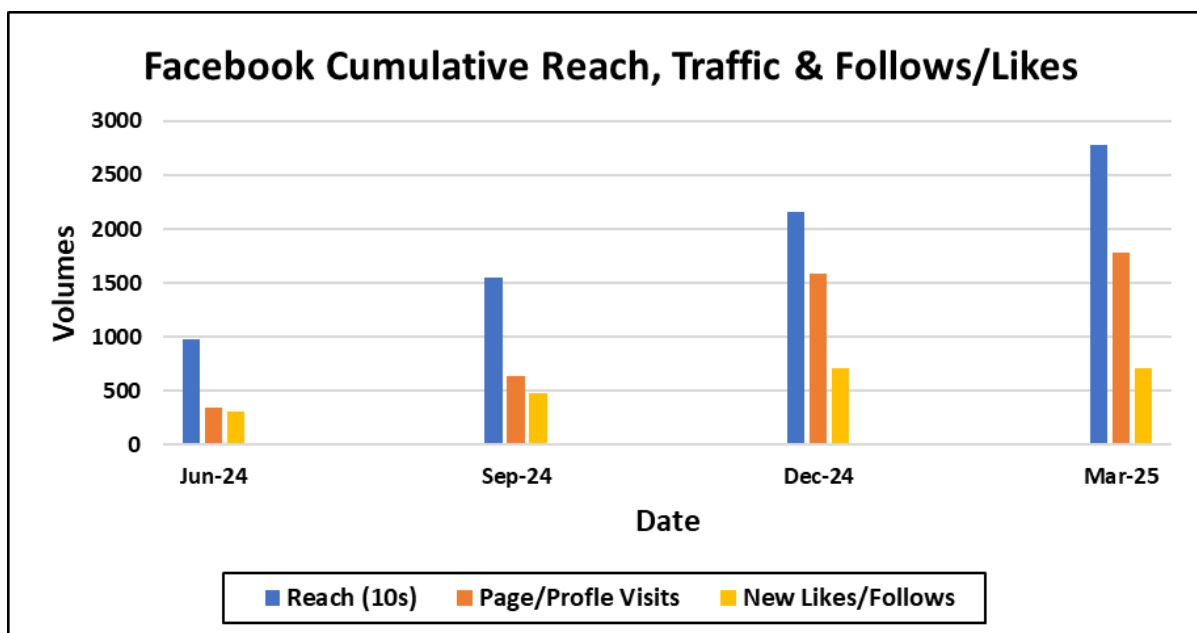

Our Performance

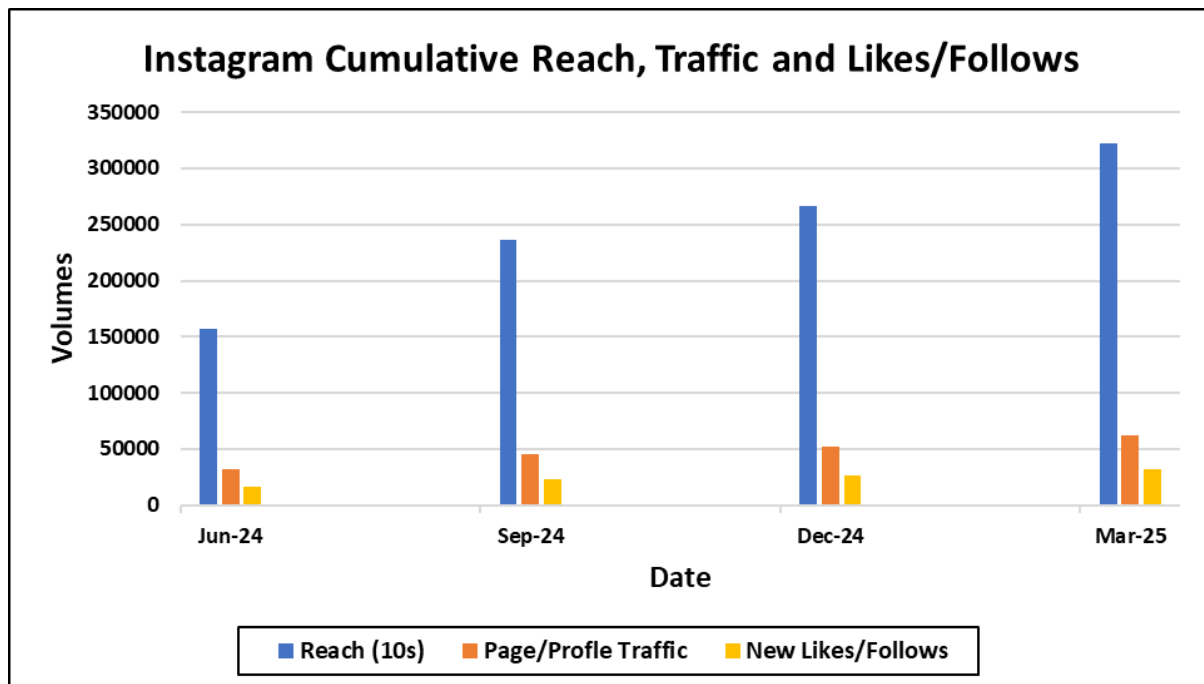

Who is Raising Our Children

Who is raising your children? Grand launch with Dattatreya Hosabale



The book *Who is Raising Your Children* is a wake-up call to parents, educators and policy makers so they can course-correct before it is too late. At the grand launch event, authors Rajiv Malhotra and Vijaya Viswanathan discuss how India's education system is under attack.

Breaking India is the broad framework or theory that captures the idea of foreign interventions in India that serve to break India's unity and sovereignty by systematically destroying its social fabric. This book is the third in the Breaking India series and BI 3.0 discusses the attack on the school system with the goal of destroying young minds.

The globalists directing these interventions operate by influencing the education, public health and legal systems. The ultimate goal is to overly sexualize children and confuse them to the point of cognitive dissonance. This

would lead to agitation within that could be used to drive them away from their parents, families and cultures, thus breaking down the family system. The healthcare system would be hijacked against their interests and the legal system would provide the framework for the globalists to operate.

International organizations like the UN, UNESCO, WHO, WEF, as well as several international NGOs like Planned Parenthood are all part of this game. All countries have signed on to the UN's 17 sustainable development goals (SDGs) which will be implemented by 2030. Points 4 and 6 deal with the education system, where things like social emotional education, comprehensive sexualizing education (CSE), global citizenship, etc. are discussed. The book describes the problems with each of these.

Who Is Raising Your Children? Our New Book | 'A MASTERFUL EXPOSÉ'



In this lecture on the recently-released book *Who is Raising Your Children*, Rajiv Malhotra explains that most of us are under the impression that parents raise

their children, although this system has subtly changed over the years. As parents get busier with careers, the ideas that really shape a child's mind are put there by the education system, including teachers and national education boards with their standardized training, exams, career counseling and so on. This education system, in turn, has come under the control of globalists, who are rich elites and belong to certain religion groups. These people want to mold the next generation in their ideology, which can then be carried by them into every sphere of life. This way, they will infiltrate education, media, policy making, corporate DEI systems and so on. So when they take over a prestigious institution like Harvard, they can use it as a spring board to get into corporate boards, and essentially into many other areas of influence.

Controlling the children is central to this strategy, which is why it becomes necessary to break them away from their local culture, which comes directly from parents. Therefore, they also work to attack and destroy the family system.

The UN's global citizenship curriculum is one such initiative, intended to convert patriotic people into globalists. Once brainwashed into accepting these ideas and aligning with them, they become foot soldiers for the global elite. [Video](#).

Hidden dangers of Western education models | Vijaya Viswanathan | Who Is Raising Your Children?



The new book *Who Is Raising Your Children* serves as a preemptive warning to those in charge of India's education system.

It is disheartening to see that the same problems irking western education today are taking shape in India as well. The very same players that have created the educational frameworks in the west are also playing a role in India's education system.

In the name of sex education, children are receiving comprehensive sexuality education (CSE). While sex education earlier included topics like bodily changes during adolescence, sexual hygiene, abstinence, responsibilities, sexual violence and abuse, prevention of unwanted pregnancies and prevention and risks of sexually transmitted diseases, HIV and AIDS, CSE does not bother with risks. Instead, it attempts to promote sex in children, teaching very young children about gender fluidity, normalizing LGBTQ lifestyle, instructing children on risky sexual acts including explicit lessons on masturbation and other sexual practices, encouraging abortion and focusing on treatment rather than prevention of sexually transmitted diseases (STDs).

What starts gradually and harmlessly does not remain so. For example, the use of pronouns initially feels like a cool trend, but ultimately leads to psychological violence as children are intimidated and pressured into compliance or cancelled/ostracised.

This book unpacks the Marxist sociological frameworks that inform education policy globally, revealing how carefully crafted language is used to gain acceptance without conveying the real agenda of destroying civilizational values. This book serves as an urgent warning for India, highlighting what lies ahead if the country does not change course quickly and decisively. [Video](#).

Breaking India 3.0 Framework explained with Rajiv Malhotra's - Who is Raising Your Children



Answering a question from the audience There are many globalist systems, for example, the Christian globalists want a Christian world, the Muslim globalists want a khilafat ruled by sharia, China wants its own globalism based on its belt and road initiative, Marxists also want their own. The question that Rajiv Malhotra raises here is where then is Vedic globalism?

The problem in India is that Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) has been ghettoed as a separate department when it should be the central factor giving direction to all disciplines. Therefore, NITI

Aayog, instead of relying on IKS, invites foreign consultancies who help frame policies based on a western worldview. This leads to the breakdown of Bharat's civilizational identity.

This book is the third in the breaking India framework. BI 1.0 was about Christian missionaries targeting poor people and villagers. BI 2.0 was a system of influencing the Indian elite through American ivy leagues and liberal arts colleges in India. This book, BI 3.0, is about bringing an education system that would sexualize and confuse children, driving them away from their parents and cultures.

The reason they want to do all this is rooted in Marxism. While Karl Marx framed an economic theory, subsequent iterations of Marxism applied the theory to culture, then race, then sexuality/LGBTQ+, then caste/Dalits and finally, khalistanis. Now it has become a coalition of victims. While there may be merit in the logic that the elite build social structures to advance their interests while the underclass have no recourse but to allow themselves to be oppressed by this system, the solution they offer is not a Vedic one, which is tragic because our tradition has many of the answers. Many Indians are upset about the US government's decision to limit H-1B visas. Rajiv Malhotra takes this opportunity to point out that these visas are only useful for labor arbitrage, the end result being the renting out of Indian brains to develop American technology, and in the process creating some billionaire middlemen. This means that while India produces the largest number of engineers, most do not spend their lives in India building Indian technology. In contrast, the Chinese use just a fraction of the H-1B visas that Indians do although they too produce a very large number of engineers. China uses its engineers to create its own technologies, so it can create products and platforms that the whole world wants to use. Therefore, unlike China, India doesn't have a single competing product with Google, Microsoft, X and so on. [Video](#).
